SELECTION PROCESS – MASTERS AND DOCTORATE

The Coordination of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education, offered in full association by the Department of Physical Education of UFV and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF, turn public that registrations will be open for the selection of candidates for the Master's and Doctorate Course, from May 26 to June 15, 2025, to start in the second half of 2025.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is structured in the Area of Concentration entitled "Exercise and Sport", with the following lines of research:

a) Physical activity and health.

Study of the effects of physical activity and sedentary lifestyle in different population groups.

b) Studies of sport and its manifestations.

Study of physiological, sociocultural, historical and psychological aspects and how these affects or are affected by sport.

1. Target audience

For the Master's course: holder of a bachelor's degree or equivalent document (observe items 3.3 and 3.4 of this Notice), issued by a course recognized by the Ministry of Education or a foreign diploma duly revalidated.

For the Doctorate course: holder of a master's degree (observe the items 3.3 and 3.4 of this Notice), issued by a course recognized by the Ministry of Education or a duly revalidated foreign diploma; author or co-author of at least one Scientific Article published or accepted in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in area 21 of CAPES – Physical Education Assessment Area, according to WebQualis (Quadrennium 2017-2020); or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS greater than 25%.

3. Registration

Registration for the selection process will be carried out exclusively online, through the UFV Selection Process Management System (GPS), at the link https://gps.ufv.br/gps-web/editais/1156/.

Only registrations made as indicated will be accepted and with due payment of the registration fee of R\$116.00. The fee must be paid using the payment slip that will be automatically generated at the time of registration, and must be paid by the day after the end of registration. Confirmation of payment is automatically displayed in the system itself, but it is advisable to keep the receipt, if requested.

The selection process for the doctoral program is continuous, with up to three schedules per year. Candidates for the doctoral program may only participate in another selection process in the same year if their application is rejected (i.e., if they do not participate in the process).

The candidate's registration will imply knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this notice, in relation to which he/she may not claim ignorance, taking responsibility for the information provided. False information above will result in the applicable penalties, as provided for in Article 299 of the Penal Code. Any candidate who has demonstrably used false documents and/or information or other illicit means to participate in the selection process will be eliminated at any time, even after registration.

3.1. Exemption from registration fee:

UFV will use the terms of article 1 of Decree No. 6,593, of 10/02/2008 to exempt the registration fee for this Selection Process, with the candidate being considered exempt if:

- i) Be registered in the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government (Cad-Único), as set out in Decree No. 11,016 of March 29, 2022; and
- ii) For demonstrably being a member of a low-income family, in accordance with Decree No. 11,016/2022 (monthly per capita family income of up to half the minimum wage).

The exemption must be requested at the time of registration directly in the Registration System until June 10, 2025, attaching proof of registration in the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government – Cad-Único. UFV will consult the Cad-Único management body to verify the veracity of the information provided by the candidate regarding items "i" and "ii". False information will result in the cancellation of the registration due to fraud and the candidate will bear the resulting legal consequences. The result of the exemption request will be informed to the candidate through the system in which they registered (GPS) and the program website (https://ppgefi.ufv.br/). It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to find out about the outcome of the exemption request. The candidate who meets the requirements of items "i" and "ii" and has his/her exemption request denied may appeal the decision within 24 hours to the secretary of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFV.

3.2. Affirmative Action Vacancies

Twenty percent (20%) of the total number of vacancies will be reserved for the affirmative action modality. The vacancies not filled in the affirmative action modality will be reallocated in the general competition modality. At the time of registration, the candidate must choose one of the modalities, as described below:

- Wide competition;
- Places reserved for affirmative action:
 - o Black (black and brown) or indigenous candidates;
 - o People with disabilities.

3.5. Approval of registrations

After analyzing the documentation presented, the Coordinating Committee of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education will decide on the approval of the registration requests, with the result being published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica andwww.ppgefi.ufv.br after the end of the registration period. Only registration requests that meet the requirements of this Notice will be accepted. Registrations that contain errors in filling out the form or are missing mandatory documentation will not be approved.

4. Selection Process

4.1. Board of Examining Teachers

The examining board for the selection process will be composed of 2 (two) permanent professors from the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFV/UFJF and will be announced on the websiteshttps://ppgefi.ufv.br/andhttps://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/ after the end of the registration period. If the candidate identifies any link that corrupts the impartiality of the examining board, must file an appeal within 24 hours after its publication. The examining board will evaluate the candidates at all stages of the selection process and will respond to appeals filed by them after the publication of the preliminary result of each stage.

At all stages the candidates will be identified by an individual code generated after registration, and will no longer be identified by name or CPF.

4.2. Steps

The selection process will consist of the following stages:

4.2.1. First Stage – Elimination and Qualification

Evaluation of the Research Project in written form by an examining board composed of 2 (two) professors, with a grade from 0 to 100 points being awarded, with an eliminatory nature for a grade below 70.0 points and classificatory for a grade equal to or above 70.0 points.

The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; relevance/adequacy of bibliographic references, timeline, financial viability; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; and 4) Adequacy of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100.0 points and, for the final grade of this item, the arithmetic mean of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion for each professor will be calculated. Projects that do not fit the research line of the intended advisor will be disqualified.

Instructions for the Research Project

The candidate must present a Research Project that is in line with the research line of the intended supervisor (see Lattes CV). The Project must follow the following outline, limited to a maximum of 07 (seven) typed pages on A4 paper, Times New Roman font size 12, spacing 1.5:

Cover Composition:

- Project title.
- Level (masters/doctorate).
- Candidate's CPF, without identifying the name.
- Name of the supervisor to whom the project will be submitted. (Note: The cover does not count towards the number of pages in the established limit).

I. Introduction

Briefly describe the problem situation addressed, citing data or information that can define its context. Substantiate your defense and line of action/theme (What?; Why?). Present an updated bibliographic review that objectively justifies the implementation of the proposal.

II. Objectives

State the objectives to be achieved by the project.

III. Method

Explain how the determined objectives are intended to be achieved (subjects, procedures and statistical treatment). In addition, the timeline and financial viability should be described.

IV. Suitability to the Supervisor's Research Line

Discuss the suitability of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended supervisor.

V. References

List the sources cited in the body of the project

Note: References do not count towards the established page limit. Consider 30 as the maximum number of references that should be cited in the project. Furthermore, attachments do not count towards the established page limit.

4.2.2. Second Stage – Elimination and Qualification

Candidates selected for the 2nd stage will participate in an oral exam, which will cover the research topics of each advisor (as per item 2 of this notice), in addition to an argument about the Research Project and the mastery of topics related to the research lines of the chosen advisors.

This stage will be evaluated with a score from 0 to 100 points, being of an eliminatory nature for candidates who obtain a score lower than 70.0 points, and classificatory for those who obtain a score equal to or higher than 70.0 points. The examining board will be composed of two (2) professors.

Candidates must:

- Be available online at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time for your argument.
- Have access to a computer with a camera, microphone and stable internet connection, ensuring your participation without interruptions.
- Present an original identification document with photo before the start of the argument.

The discussion will be held via the Google Meet platform. The link to access the virtual room will be sent by email to the candidate by the desired advisor. Important: The candidate should regularly check his/her inbox and spam folder. Failure to appear — that is, failure to access the virtual room at the time established for the discussion — will result in disqualification from the selection process.

The candidate will be assessed on the Research Project based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Up-to-date bibliographical references; 5) Schedule; 6) Financial viability; 7) Skills and abilities to carry out the proposed Research Project; 8) Adequacy of the project to the research lines of the program and the desired advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100 points and, for the final grade of this item, the arithmetic mean of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion will be calculated. The argument will be recorded, with due storage of the record guaranteed.

4.2.3. Third Stage – Qualifying

Candidates selected for the 3rd stage will be subjected to a Curriculum Vitae Assessment by an examining board composed of 2 (two) professors. The organization of the curriculum must follow the model described in Annex I of this notice, and candidates who fail to do so will be disqualified. The supporting documents, which must follow the same sequence as the Curriculum Vitae, must be attached to the Miscellaneous Certificates section in a separate PDF. Annex I will also be made available in editable format (.doc) to facilitate completion on the Program and GPS System websites.

5. Final Grade and Classification

The final grade will be calculated by adding together the three stages of the selection process (Stage 1 + Stage 2 + Stage 3) and published on the websites https://ppgefi.ufv.br/ and https://ppgedufisica/ after the third stage. The final classification will be from highest to lowest score.

- ➤ In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the tiebreaker will be determined by the highest score obtained in the 1st Stage.
- > The list of approved candidates will be composed of the first candidates who occupy the positions of the indicated supervisor.
- > The list of substitutes will be composed of the candidates who were classified, but who exceeded the number of vacancies offered by the supervisor indicated in the registration form.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is not obliged to fill all the vacancies offered.

6. Registration

6.1. Candidates with UFV advisors

Successful candidates must confirm their interest in the vacancy via the GPS system, and their documentation will be retrieved from the system itself to enroll after the final classification is announced. Successful candidates who do not confirm their interest will be considered to have withdrawn, and consequently, the next candidate on the surplus list will be called by the advisor, who will be contacted by email and/or telephone and/or through the website.https://ppgefi.ufv.br/.

6.2. Candidates with UFJF advisors

Approved candidates must submit/send their documentation for registration and subsequent enrollment after the final classification is announced, as soon as requested, to the Secretary of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF. Approved candidates who do not submit/send the documentation within this period will be considered to have withdrawn and, consequently,

the next candidate on the list of surplus candidates will be called by their advisor, who will be contacted by email and/or telephone and/or through the website https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/.

6.3. Enrollment and courses

The candidates will have their enrollment confirmed after the final result is announced, according to the calendar of each campus. The subjects to be taken must be defined between the candidate and their respective advisors. If there are no courses available by the beginning of the following semester, the student will be enrolled in "Research".
