SELECTION PROCESS - DOCTORATE

The Coordination of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education, offered in full association by the Department of Physical Education of UFV and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF, announces that applications will be open for the selection of candidates for the Doctoral Course, from October 14th to November 10th, to begin in the first period of 2026.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is structured in the Area of Concentration entitled "**Exercise and Sport**", with the following lines of research:

a) Physical activity and health.

Study of the effects of physical activity and sedentary lifestyle in different population groups.

b) Studies of sport and its manifestations.

Study of physiological, sociocultural, historical and psychological aspects and how these affect or are affected by sport.

1. Target audience

For the Doctorate course: holder of a master's degree (observe items 3.3 and 3.4 of this Notice), issued by a course recognized by the Ministry of Education or a duly revalidated foreign degree; author or co-author of at least one Scientific Article published or accepted in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in area 21 of CAPES - Physical Education Assessment Area, according to WebQualis (Quadrennium 2017-2020); or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS higher than 25%.

3. Registration

Registration for the selection process will be carried out exclusively online, through the UFV Selection Process Management System (GPS), at the link <https://gps.ufv.br/gps-web/editais/1266/>

Only registrations completed as indicated and with due payment of the R\$116.00 registration fee will be accepted. The fee must be paid using the payment slip that will be automatically generated at the time of registration, and must be paid by the day after the registration deadline. Payment confirmation is automatically displayed in the system itself, but it is recommended that you keep the receipt if requested.

Selection for the doctoral program is ongoing, with up to three schedules per year. Candidates for the doctoral program may only participate in another selection process in the same year if their application is rejected (i.e., if they do not participate in the process).

Applications that do not submit the requested documentation in accordance with the rules of this announcement will be rejected. The candidate's application implies knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this announcement, in relation to which they may not claim ignorance, and they are responsible for the information provided. False information in the above information will result in the applicable penalties, as provided for in Article 299 of the Penal Code. Candidates who have demonstrably used false documents and/or information or other illicit means to participate in the selection process will be disqualified at any time, even after enrollment.

3.1. Exemption from registration fee:

UFV will use the terms of article 1 of Decree No. 6,593, of 10/02/2008 to exempt the registration fee in this Selection Process, with the candidate being considered exempt if:

- i) Be registered in the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government (Cad-Único), as set out in Decree No. 11,016 of March 29, 2022; and
- ii) For proven reasons, a member of a low-income family, in accordance with Decree No. 11,016/2022 (monthly per capita family income of up to half the minimum wage).

The exemption must be requested at the time of registration directly through the Registration System by November 8, 2025, attaching proof of registration with the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government (Cad-Único). UFV will consult with the Cad-Único management body to verify the veracity of the information provided by the candidate regarding items "i" and "ii." False information will result in cancellation of the registration due to fraud, and the candidate will bear the resulting legal consequences. The result of the exemption request will be communicated to the candidate through the system through which they registered (GPS) and on the program website (<https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>). It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to obtain information about the result of the exemption request. Candidates who meet the requirements of items "i" and "ii" and have their exemption request denied may appeal the decision within 24 hours to the secretariat of the Graduate Program in Physical Education at UFV.

3.2. Affirmative Action Positions

Twenty percent (20%) of the total vacancies will be reserved for affirmative action candidates, with two vacancies for Black (Black and mixed race), Indigenous, or Quilombola candidates, and one vacancy for candidates with disabilities. Any vacancies not filled under the affirmative action system will be reallocated to the open competition system. When registering, candidates must choose one of the two options, as described below:

- Wide competition;
- Places reserved for affirmative action: the Black (black and brown) or indigenous candidates; the People with disabilities.

3.5. Approval of registrations

After reviewing the submitted documentation, the Coordinating Committee of the Graduate Program in Physical Education will decide whether to accept the applications. The results will be published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br after the end of the application period. Only applications that meet the requirements of this Notice will be accepted. Applications containing filling errors or missing required documentation will be rejected.

4. Selection Process

4.1. Board of Examining Teachers

The examining board for the selection process will be composed of two permanent faculty members of the Graduate Program in Physical Education at UFV/UFJF. The results will be announced on the websites <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/> and <https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/> after the end of the application period. The examining board will evaluate candidates at all stages of the selection process and will respond to any appeals filed by them after the preliminary results for each stage are published.

At all stages, candidates will be identified by an individual code generated after registration, and will no longer be identified by name or CPF.

4.2. Steps

The selection process will consist of the following stages:

4.2.1. First Stage – Elimination and Qualification

Evaluation of the Research Project and the Letter of Suitability to the Supervisor's Research Line in written form by an examining board composed of 2 (two) professors, with a grade awarded from 0 to 100 points, of an eliminatory nature for a grade below 70.0 points and classificatory for a grade equal to or above 70.0 points.

The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; relevance/adequacy of bibliographic references, timeline, and financial viability; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; and 4) Adequacy of the project to the intended advisor's research lines. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100.0 points, and the final grade for this item will be calculated by the arithmetic mean of the scores obtained in each evaluation criterion for each faculty member. Projects that do not fit the intended advisor's research line (see Lattes CV) will be disqualified.

Instructions for the Research Project

The Project must follow the following outline, being limited to a maximum of 7 (seven) typed pages on A4 paper, font *Times New Roman* size 12, spacing 1.5:

Cover Composition (does not count towards the established page limit):

- Project title.
- Level (masters / doctorate).
- Candidate's CPF, without identifying the name.
- Name of the advisor to whom the project will be submitted.

I. Introduction

Briefly describe the problem situation being addressed, citing data or information that can define its context. Substantiate your defense and line of action/theme (What?; Why?). Present an updated literature review that objectively justifies the implementation of the proposal.

II. Objectives

State the objectives to be achieved by the project.

III. Method

Explain how you intend to achieve the determined objectives (type of study, subjects, procedures and data analysis). In addition, the timeline and financial feasibility should be described.

IV. References (does not count towards the page limit)

List the sources cited in the body of the project. Consider a maximum of 30 references that should be cited in the project.

V. Annexes (Optional, does not count towards the page limit)

Documents not prepared by the author that serve to support, prove or illustrate the main content of the project.

VI. Appendix (Optional, does not count towards the established page limit)

Texts written by the author to complement the main work.

4.2.2. Second Stage – Elimination and Qualification

Candidates classified for the 2nd stage will participate in an oral exam, which will cover the research topics of each advisor (as per item 2 of this notice), in addition to an argument about the Research Project and the mastery of topics related to the intended advisor's line of research.

This stage will be evaluated with a score from 0 to 100 points, being of an eliminatory nature for candidates who obtain a score lower than 70.0 points, and classificatory for those who obtain a score equal to or higher than 70.0 points. The examining board will be composed of two (2) professors.

Candidates must:

- Be available online at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time for your argument;
- Have access to a computer with a camera, microphone and stable internet connection, ensuring your participation without interruptions;
- Present original identification document with photo before the start of the argument.

The argument will be carried out through the platform *Google Meet*. The *link* The access code to the virtual room will be sent by email to the candidate by the intended advisor, with a copy to the secretariat, at least 48 hours in advance. Important: The candidate should regularly check their inbox and email *spam*. The candidate's failure to appear — that is, failure to access the virtual room at the time established for the questioning — will result in his/her disqualification from the selection process.

The candidate's Research Project will be evaluated based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Current bibliographic references; 5) Schedule; 6) Financial viability; 7) Skills and abilities to carry out the proposed Research Project; 8) Adequacy of the project to the desired advisor's line of research. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100 points, and the final grade for this item will be calculated by the arithmetic mean of the scores obtained in each evaluation criterion. The evaluation will be recorded, with due storage of the record guaranteed.

4.2.3. Third Stage – Qualifying

Candidates selected for the third stage will undergo a CV evaluation by an examining board of two faculty members. CVs must follow the format described in Annex I of this announcement, and candidates who fail to do so will be disqualified. Supporting documents, which must follow the same sequence as the CV, must be attached separately (in the APPENDIX 2 section of the GPS). Each supporting document/certificate must have the item number and description as its title or caption. Annex I will also be made available in editable format (.doc) for ease of completion on the Program and GPS System websites.

5. Final Grade and Classification

The final grade will be calculated by adding the three stages of the selection process (Stage 1 + Stage 2 + Stage 3) and published on the websites <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/> and <https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/> after the third stage. The final classification will be from highest to lowest grade.

- In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the tiebreaker will be determined by the highest score obtained in the 1st Stage.
- The list of approved candidates will be composed of the first candidates who occupy the vacancies of the indicated supervisor.
- The list of substitutes will be composed of the candidates who were classified, but who exceeded the number of vacancies offered by the supervisor indicated in the registration form.
- An advisor may make their position available to another if no candidates are selected.
- An advisor may select a candidate who applied for their position and transfer them to another advisor.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is not obliged to fill all vacancies offered.

6. Registration

6.1. Candidates with UFV advisors

Successful candidates must confirm their interest in the vacancy via the GPS system, and their documentation will be retrieved from the system for enrollment after the final ranking is announced. Successful candidates who do not confirm their interest will be considered to have withdrawn, and consequently, the next candidate on the surplus list will be called by their advisor, who will be contacted by email and/or telephone and/or through the website <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>.

6.2. Candidates with UFJF advisors

Approved candidates must submit/send their documentation for registration and subsequent enrollment after the final classification is announced, as soon as requested, to the Secretariat of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF. The approved candidate who does not submit/send the documentation within this period will be considered a withdrawal and, consequently, the subsequent candidate on the surplus list will be called by the advisor, who will be contacted by email and/or telephone and/or through the website <https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/>.

6.3. Enrollment and courses

Candidates will be enrolled after the final results are released, according to each campus's calendar, for the first semester of 2026. The courses to be taken must be defined between the candidate and his/her respective advisor. If no relevant course is available by the beginning of the following semester, the student will be enrolled in "Research."

The granting or denial of the appeal filed by the candidate will be announced on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, websites of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFJF and UFV, and the response will be sent by email to the candidate.

The Master's and Doctoral programs are offered in full partnership between the Federal University of Viçosa and the Federal University of Juiz de Fora. Therefore, the course activities are developed at both universities, so students must be available to travel between the two institutions, according to the schedule of activities established by the coordinator and/or advisor.

After being admitted, the student must pay attention to the requirements present in the regulations of the respective university in which the student will be enrolled (UFV or UFJF).
