## SELECTION PROCESS – MASTER'S and DOCTORAL DEGREES

The Coordination of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education, Offered in full association by the Department of Physical Education of UFV and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF, is announced to the public that applications will be open for the selection of candidates for the Master's and Doctoral programs from May 11 to May 27, 2026, to begin in the second half of 2026.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is structured around the area of concentration entitled "Exercise and Sport," with the following lines of research:

**a) Physical activity and health.**

Study of the effects of physical activity and sedentary behavior in different population groups.

**b) Studies of sport and its manifestations.**

A study of the physiological, sociocultural, historical, and psychological aspects of sport, and how these affect or are affected by it.

### 1. Target audience

For the Master's course: holder of a bachelor's degree or equivalent document ((See items 3.3 and 3.4 of this Notice), issued by a course recognized by the Ministry of Education or a foreign diploma that has been duly validated.

For the Doctoral course: holder of a master's degree (see items 3.3 and 3.4 (This Notice), issued by a course recognized by the Ministry of Education or a duly revalidated foreign diploma; author or co-author of at least one scientific article published or accepted in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in area 21 of CAPES – Physical Education Evaluation Area, according to WebQualis (Quadrennium 2021-2024); or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS greater than 25%.

### 3. Registration

Applications for the selection process will be accepted exclusively online, through the UFV Selection Process Management System (GPS), at the following link: <https://gps.ufv.br/gps-web/editais/1524/>.

When filling out the GPS application, select the Viçosa Campus as the location, even for UFJF advisor positions. This is purely for technical reasons, as the system used in this selection process was developed by UFV.

Only applications submitted in accordance with the instructions will be accepted, and with the due payment of the registration fee of R\$116.00. The fee must be paid using the payment slip that will be automatically generated at the time of registration, and must be paid by the day after the registration deadline. Payment confirmation is automatically displayed in the system, however, it is advisable to keep the receipt in case it is requested.

Selection for the master's program occurs once a year, with entry in the second semester. Selection for the doctoral program, however, is on a rolling basis, with up to three schedules per year, depending on demand. Candidates for the doctoral program may only participate in another selection process in the same year if their application is rejected (i.e., they do not participate in the process).

Candidates must check the GPS system before the registration deadline to verify if any documentation adjustments have been requested. Registrations that do not include the requested documentation according to the rules of this notice by the registration deadline will be rejected. The candidate's registration implies knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this notice, regarding which they cannot claim ignorance, and they are responsible for the information provided. False information will result in applicable penalties, as stipulated in Article 299 of the Penal Code. Any candidate who has demonstrably used false documents and/or information or other illicit means to participate in the selection process will be eliminated at any time, even after enrollment.

### **3.1. Exemption from the registration fee:**

UFV will employ the terms of Article 1 of Decree No. 6,593, of October 2, 2008, for exemption from the registration fee in this Selection Process, with the candidate being considered exempt if:

- i) If you are registered in the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government (Cad-Único), as provided for in Decree No. 11,016, of March 29, 2022; and
- ii) For those who are demonstrably members of low-income families, as defined in Decree No. 11.016/2022 (monthly per capita family income of up to half the minimum wage).

The exemption must be requested at the time of registration directly in the Registration System until May 18, 2026, at 11:00 PM, attaching proof of registration in the Single Registry for Social Programs of the Federal Government – Cad-Único. UFRV will consult the managing body of Cad-Único to verify the veracity of the information provided by the candidate regarding items “i” and “ii”. False information will result in the annulment of the registration due to fraud, and the candidate will bear the resulting legal consequences. The result of the exemption request will be informed to the candidate through the system in which the registration was made (GPS). It is the candidate's sole responsibility to find out the result of the exemption request. Candidates who meet the requirements of items “i” and “ii” and have their exemption request denied may appeal the decision within 48 hours to the secretariat of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFRV.

### **3.2. Affirmative Action Vacancies**

Twenty percent (20%) of the total vacancies will be reserved for affirmative action, according to the latest IBGE census of the state of Minas Gerais. Vacancies not filled through affirmative action will be reallocated to the general competition category. At the time of registration, the candidate must choose one of the categories, as described below:

- Wide competition;
- Positions reserved for affirmative action:
  - Black (both Black and mixed-race) or Indigenous candidates;
  - People with disabilities.

- Graduation Diploma, front and back, OR a statement issued by the competent body of your institution of origin, which includes the expected date for graduation, in order to guarantee that, at the time of enrollment, if approved, the candidate is in possession of the graduation diploma, or the Declaration/Certificate of Completion of Undergraduate Course or the certificate of dissertation defense;
- Academic transcript from undergraduate course;
- Master's Degree Diploma, front and back, or a statement issued by the competent body of your institution of origin, indicating the expected date for completion of the Master's Degree course, in order to guarantee that, at the time of enrollment, if approved, the candidate will be in possession of the Master's Degree diploma or the Declaration/Certificate of Completion of the Master's Degree course, or a certificate of dissertation defense (only for doctoral candidates);
- Most recent academic transcript from the Master's degree program (only for doctoral candidates);
- Curriculum vitae, according to the model in Annex I of this Notice.
- Proof of Curriculum Vitae; including, for doctoral candidates, at least one published Scientific Article or a copy of the Acceptance Letter sent by the journal, as author or co-author, in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in CAPES area 21 – Physical Education Evaluation Area, according to WebQualis (Quadrennium 2021-2024) or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS greater than 25%, until the end of the registration period of this Call for Proposals;
- Research Project. The Research Project must follow the instructions described in item 4.2.1 of this Call for Proposals.

**3.4. Required documents for foreign candidates to apply for registration.(Note: all documents, without exception, must be in high resolution and in PDF format).**

- Birth certificate or marriage certificate, if married;
- Diploma of graduation course, front and back, or Certificate of the Hague Convention with apostille or translation depending on the country of origin;
- Academic transcript from the undergraduate course, with annotation or translation depending on the country of origin;
- Master's degree diploma with acknowledgment, front and back, or Hague Convention Certificate (only for doctoral candidates);
- Academic transcript from the Master's degree program, with annotation or translation depending on the country of origin;
- Curriculum vitae, according to the model in Annex I of this Notice.
- Proof of Curriculum Vitae; including, for doctoral candidates, at least one published Scientific Article or a copy of the Acceptance Letter sent by the journal, as author or co-author, in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in CAPES area 21 – Physical Education Evaluation Area, according to WebQualis (Quadrennium 2021-2024) or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS greater than 25%, until the end of the registration period of this Call for Proposals;
- Research Project. The Research Project must follow the instructions described in item 4.2.1 of this Call for Proposals.

**3.5. Registration Approval**

After reviewing the submitted documentation, the Coordinating Committee of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education will decide on the approval of the registration requests, with the results being published on the websites [www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica](http://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica) and <http://ppgefi.ufv.br/>. After the registration period ends, only applications that meet the requirements of this notice will be accepted. Applications with filling errors or missing required documentation will not be approved.

## **4. Selection Process**

### **4.1. Board of Examining Teachers**

The selection committee will consist of 2 (two) permanent faculty members from the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFV/UFJF and will be announced on the websites <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/> and <https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/> after the registration period ends. The examining board will evaluate the candidates at all stages of the selection process and will respond to appeals filed by them after the publication of the preliminary results of each stage. At all stages, the (to the) candidates (to the) They will be identified by name.

### **4.2. Steps**

The selection process will consist of the following stages:

#### **4.2.1. First Stage – Elimination and Qualification Round**

Evaluation of the Research Project in written form by an examining board composed of 2 (two) professors, with the assignment of a grade from 0 to 100 points, of an eliminatory nature for a grade lower than 70.0 points and classificatory for a grade equal to or higher than 70.0 points.

The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical foundation; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; relevance/adequacy of bibliographic references, schedule, financial viability; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; and 4) Suitability of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100.0 points, and the final grade for this item will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion for each professor. Projects that do not align with the research line of the intended advisor will be disqualified.

## **Instructions for the Research Project**

The candidate must submit a Research Project that aligns with the research focus of the intended supervisor (see Lattes curriculum). The Project should follow the following outline, being limited to a maximum of 7 (seven) typed pages on A4 paper, Times New Roman font size 12, 1.5 spacing:

### Cover Composition:

- Project title.
- Candidate's name
- Level (Master's / Doctorate).
- Name of the supervisor to whom the project will be submitted.  
(Note: The cover does not count towards the established page limit).

### I. Introduction

Briefly describe the problem situation addressed, citing data or information that may define its context. Justify your argument and line of action/theme (What?; Why?). Present an updated literature review that objectively justifies the execution of the proposal.

### II. Objectives

State the objectives to be achieved by the project.

### III. Method

Explain how you intend to achieve the stated objectives (subjects, procedures, and statistical treatment). In addition, a timeline and financial feasibility should be described.

#### IV. Alignment with the Supervisor's Research Focus

Discuss the suitability of the project to the research areas of the program and the intended advisor.

#### V. References

List the sources cited in the body of the project.

Note: References do not count towards the established page limit. Consider 30 as the maximum number of references that should be cited in the project. Additionally, appendices do not count towards the established page limit.

#### **4.2.2. Second Stage – Elimination and Qualification Rounds**

Candidates who qualify for the 2nd stage will participate in an oral exam, which will cover the research topics of each advisor (as per item 2 of this notice), in addition to a discussion about the Research Project and the mastery of topics related to the research lines of the chosen advisors.

This stage will be evaluated with a score from 0 to 100 points, being eliminatory for candidates who obtain a score lower than 70.0 points, and classificatory for those who obtain a score equal to or higher than 70.0 points. The examining board will be composed of two (2) professors.

Candidates should:

- Be available online at least 30 minutes before your scheduled oral examination time.
- Having access to a computer with a camera, microphone, and stable internet connection ensures uninterrupted participation.
- Please present an original photo ID before the start of the hearing.

The oral examination will be conducted via the Google Meet platform. The link to access the virtual room will be sent to the candidate by email from their chosen advisor. Important: The candidate must regularly check their inbox and spam folder. Failure to attend—that is, failure to access the virtual room at the scheduled time for the oral examination—will result in the candidate's disqualification from the selection process.

The candidate will be assessed on the Research Project based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical foundation; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Up-to-date bibliographic references; 5) Timeline; 6) Financial viability; 7) Aptitudes and skills for carrying out the proposed Research Project; 8) Suitability of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended supervisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100 points, and the final grade for this item will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion. The hearing will be recorded, with proper storage of the recording guaranteed.

#### **4.2.3. Third Stage – Qualifying Round**

Candidates who qualify for the 3rd stage will undergo a Curriculum Vitae evaluation by an examining board composed of 2 (two) professors. The curriculum vitae must follow the model described in Annex I of this notice; any candidate who fails to do so will be disqualified. Supporting documents, which must follow the same sequence as the Curriculum Vitae, must be attached in a separate PDF format in the Miscellaneous Certificates section. Annex I will also be available in editable format (.doc) to facilitate completion on the Program and GPS System websites.

### **5. Final Grade and Classification**

The final grade will be calculated by adding the scores from the three stages of the selection process (Stage 1 + Stage 2 + Stage 3) and will be published on the websites <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/> and [www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/](http://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/). After the third stage, the final ranking will be from highest to lowest score.

- In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the tiebreaker will be the highest score obtained in the 1st Stage.

- The list of approved candidates will consist of the first candidates who fill the vacancies of the indicated advisor.
- The waiting list will consist of candidates who qualified but exceeded the number of places offered by the supervisor indicated on the registration form.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is not obligated to fill all available places.

## 6. Registration

### 6.1. Candidates with advisors from UFV

Successful candidates must confirm their interest in the position via the GPS system, retrieving their documentation from the GPS system itself for enrollment after the final ranking is published. Any successful candidate who does not confirm their interest will be considered to have withdrawn, and consequently, the next candidate on the waiting list will be contacted by their advisor via email and/or telephone and/or through the website. <https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>.

### 6.2. Candidates with advisors from UFJF

Successful candidates must submit their documentation for registration and subsequent enrollment after the final ranking is published, as soon as requested, to the Postgraduate Secretariat in Physical Education at the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF. Any successful candidate who fails to submit the documentation within this period will be considered to have withdrawn, and consequently, the next candidate on the waiting list will be contacted by email and/or telephone and/or through the website. <https://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica/>.

### 6.3. Enrollment and course registration

You(to the)candidates(to the)Students will be officially enrolled after the final results are released, according to each campus's schedule. The courses to be taken must be determined between the...(the)candidate(the)and their respective advisor. If no courses are available by the start of the following semester, the student will be enrolled in "Research".

## 8. Research Grants

The selection processes for research grants are independent of admission to master's and doctoral programs. The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education offers scholarships from CAPES and FAPEMIG, with selection based on the candidates' curriculum evaluation. The granting of scholarships is subject to quota availability and follows different rules for each institution; therefore, there is no guarantee of a scholarship for students.

## 9. Final Observations

All results will be published via the websites [www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica](http://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica) and <http://ppgefi.ufv.br/>. The results from the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFJF and UFV are not applicable to any stages of this Call for Applications. They are exclusively for admission in 2026 and to the Call for Applications (and stage) to which the candidate applied.

The candidate will have the right to appeal to the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education (UFV/UFJF) within 48 hours of the publication of the result on the website of the institution responsible for the selection (UFV): The form for submitting the appeal will be available at the following web addresses: [www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica](http://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica) and <http://ppgefi.ufv.br/> and in the attachments of the registration system. Appeals must be submitted in writing, dated and signed by the applicant, and sent to [toppg.faeffd@ufjf.br](mailto:toppg.faeffd@ufjf.br) and [ppgefi@ufv.br](mailto:ppgefi@ufv.br) will be analyzed by the responsible panel or the coordinating committee. The acceptance or rejection of the appeal filed by the candidate will be published on the websites [www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica](http://www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica) and <http://ppgefi.ufv.br/>. The application will be sent to the candidate via email through the websites of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education at UFJF and UFV.

The Master's and Doctoral programs are offered in full association by the Federal University of Viçosa and the Federal University of Juiz de Fora. Therefore, course activities are developed at both universities, meaning students must be available to travel between the two institutions according to the schedule of activities planned by the coordinator and/or advisor.

After being admitted, the student must pay attention to the requirements present in the regulations of the respective university in which the student will be enrolled (UFV or UFJF). Foreign students will need to request their Individual Taxpayer Registry number (CPF) for enrollment, as well as other relevant documentation according to the institution and country of origin.
